
VISION for a New Shelter






SITE & FLOOR PLAN

The time has come

to expand in order to continue providing quality care for animals in Central Minnesota. Our vision for a new shelter will almost **double** the square footage of our existing shelter. It will enable us to do so much more for **local animals in need**, and allow us to assist more animals from neighboring counties, cities and states. In addition to the images in this booklet that show examples of what a new shelter could look like, a new shelter will include things that cannot be seen; more efficient heating and cooling units providing **greater comfort** for all, better air-flow and exchange which will create a **healthier environment**, and better sound-proofing to create **calmer spaces** for the **animals**.

The new shelter will be built on our existing land, directly behind our current shelter.





COLONIES

We envision multiple **community cat rooms** that can house groups of **friendly felines**, providing natural light and **plenty of space** for them to climb, play and lounge.

LARGER KENNELS

Each animal will have housing units that are built to best practice industry standards for shelter animals.






GET ACQUAINTED ROOMS

We envision the addition of **multiple rooms** for visitors to meet and spend time **getting to know animals** outside of their kennels.

VOLUNTEER / HUMANE EDUCATION ROOM

We envision the addition of **two separate** rooms for volunteer projects and humane education programs.





ANIMAL EXAM ROOM & SURGERY SUITE

We envision a **state-of-the-art** exam room with everything needed to perform **thorough exams** on the animals, **putting their health first** so that they have the **best start possible** in their new homes. An **in-house surgery suite** will allow us to perform spays and neuters in a more **timely** and **efficient** manner.

LARGER LOBBY & SEPARATE AREAS FOR ADOPTIONS/INTAKE

We envision **more space** in our lobby and store to **better serve the community**, with stations for **individual adoptions** versus everything at one counter. We also envision a separate, more private **animal intake** area.
